

Before Going on Holidays

- ✍️ Don't indicate publicly that you'll be away from home.
- ✍️ Ensure doors and windows are closed and locked.
- ✍️ Install an intrusion alarm.
- ✍️ Avoid the overflowing of your mailbox.
- ✍️ Make a list of your valuables and write down the serial numbers.
- ✍️ If possible, leave the house to go on vacation, in the hours of less movement.
- ✍️ Ask a trusted friend or neighbor to check in periodically.
- ✍️ Leave your valuable items in a safe place.

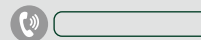

SAFE TOURISM PROGRAM

In The Hotel

- ✍ In public areas always never leave your baggage unattended.
- ✍ Leave your valuable items in your room safe.
- ✍ When leaving the hotel, ensure doors and windows are closed and locked.
- ✍ Hand your key in to the reception staff.
- ✍ Lock all pieces of luggage.

Walking

- ✍ Do not carry large amounts of cash.
- ✍ Learn to carry your purse or wallet safely.
- ✍ Hand carry important documents or keep them in a money belt.
- ✍ Plan your route carefully, travel on main streets, and use maps.
- ✍ Avoid to walk on dark alleyways.
- ✍ Keep your valuables on sight.

Driving

- ✍ When parking chooses lighted places.
- ✍ Keep your valuables out of sight.
- ✍ Do not park in a place which may obstruct others.
- ✍ Ensure doors and windows are closed and locked.

Restaurants and other establishments

- ✍ Keep your belongings hidden and keep your bag in front of you, not behind you.
- ✍ Never miss your bank cards of sight.
- ✍ Payments must always be made in front of you.

On public transport

- ✍ Pay special attention to the entrance and exit.
- ✍ Keep your valuables close to you and out of sight.

On the Beach

- ✍ Unless needed, avoid carry valuable items.
- ✍ If going for a swim, choose a place where you can keep an eye on your belongings.

During a robbery

- ✍ Stay calm, quiet and in control of yourself.
- ✍ Do not fight the robber or offer resistance.
- ✍ Take note of as many details as you can.
- ✍ Take mental notes of height, weight, clothes, or other distinguishing aspects

After a robbery

- ✍ Immediately after the robber leaves, contact law enforcement to report your situation.
- ✍ You can use the police report certificate to request new documents.
